BY-LAW No. 787-2006

To name the private lanes on the south side of Treewood Street between Midland Avenue and Brockley Drive as "Archibald Mews" and "Tiller Lane".

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto website from September 5 to September 12, 2006, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 13, 2006, and it is appropriate to name the private lanes on the south side of Treewood Street between Midland Avenue and Brockley Drive as "Archibald Mews" and "Tiller Lane";

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:


- 1. The private lanes shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated March 2, 2006 are named "Archibald Mews" and "Tiller Lane".
- 2. Sundance (Treewood) Developments Inc., its agent or successor, shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage.
- 3. Sundance (Treewood) Developments Inc., its agent or successor, shall maintain at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.
