BY-LAW No. 789-2006

To name the private lane at 134, 136 and 138 Finch Avenue West as "Routliffe Lane".

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto website from September 6 to September 12, 2006, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 13, 2006, and it is appropriate to name the private lane at 134, 136 and 138 Finch Avenue West as "Routliffe Lane";

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:


- 1. The private lane shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated June 24, 2005 is named "Routliffe Lane".
