BY-LAW No. 811-2006

To name the proposed private lane at 1100 Islington Avenue as “Furrow Lane”.

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from September 6 to September 13, 2006, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 13, 2006, and it is appropriate to name the proposed private lane at 1100 Islington Avenue as “Furrow Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The proposed private lane at 1100 Islington Avenue be named as “Furrow Lane”;
2. Zanini Developments Inc. pay the costs estimates to be in the amount of \$420.00 for the fabrication and installation of the street name signs; and
3. Zanini Developments Inc., its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.
