**BY-LAW No. 814-2006**

**To rename the east-west portion of Hanna Avenue as “Snooker Street”.**

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from September 6 to September 13, 2006, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 13, 2006, and it is appropriate to rename the east-west portion of Hanna Avenue as “Snooker Street”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land comprised of the east-west portion of the public highway Hanna Avenue, extending easterly from Atlantic Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 21299-0151 (LT).

Part of Pacific Avenue Plan 765 Toronto abutting the southerly limits of Lots 51 to 56, inclusive, on Plan 765 Toronto, known as part of Hanna Avenue

City of Toronto and Province of Ontario

Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is renamed as “Snooker Street”.
