## BY-LAW No. 820-2006

WHEREAS it is recommended that part of the above-grade portion of the public lane known as Victoria Street Lane, between Premises No. 26 and 38 Shuter Street, be permanently closed and be conveyed upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause 63 of Toronto and East York Community Council Report 6, as adopted by City of Toronto Council at its meeting held on July 25, 26 and 27, 2006; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting held on September 13, 2006;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The above-grade portion of the public lane known as Victoria Street Lane, between Premises No. 26 and 38 Shuter Street, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public lane:

Part of PIN 21098-0105 (LT).

Part of the Public Lane known as Victoria Street Lane being part of the Lane on Plan 22A dedicated as Public Lane by City of Toronto By-law No. 710-88 (CA25124) designated as PART 1 on Plan 66R-22568, City of Toronto and Province of Ontario Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66).
