CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 831-2006

To authorize the alteration of the south side of Bloor Street West by widening the pavement from a point 92 metres west of Queen's Park/Avenue Road to a point 20 metres further west, to construct a lay-by.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alterations are authorized:

The widening of the pavement on the south side of Bloor Street West, from a point 92 metres west of Queen's Park/Avenue Road to a point 20 metres further west, by the construction of a lay-by, generally as shown on Drawing No. 4215-8522 dated August 2006, on file in the offices of Traffic Operations, Toronto and East York District, West Area.

2. The Royal Ontario Museum shall be responsible for all costs associated with the construction and signage required for the implementation of the lay-by as set out in Toronto and East York Community Council Report 7, Clause 68 as adopted by Council on September 25, 26 and 27, 2006.
