## CITY OF TORONTO

## **BY-LAW No. 856-2006**

## To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt a portion of a swimming pool enclosure on the property municipally known as 10 Paris Court from certain construction standards.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** Section 447-5 of Chapter 447, Fences, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing fence made partly of Eon and forming part of a swimming pool enclosure in the rear yard of the property known municipally in 2006 as 10 Paris Court, may be retained despite the requirement in § 447-3E(2) that swimming pool enclosures be constructed of chain link, metal picket or wood materials, and the portion of the swimming pool enclosure made of chain link fencing with mesh openings of 50 millimetres may be retained despite the requirement in § 447-3E(2)(a) that the mesh size of chain link in fences used in swimming pool enclosures be a maximum of 38 millimetres, provided that the fence is brought into compliance with Chapter 447, Fences, when replaced.
