**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 859-2006**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt a tennis court enclosure which forms part of a swimming pool enclosure for the property municipally known as 172 The Bridle Path, from the mesh size requirements.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 447-5 of Chapter 447, Fences, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing chain link tennis court enclosure located in the rear yard of the property known municipally as 170 The Bridle Path, which is constructed with 50 millimetre mesh openings and which forms part of a swimming pool enclosure for a pool located at 172 The Bridle Path, may be used as part of the swimming pool enclosure despite the requirement in § 447-3E(2)(a) that a chain link fence used in such enclosures be constructed with a mesh size of no greater than 38 millimetres, provided that the swimming pool enclosure is brought into compliance with Chapter 447, Fences, when the tennis court enclosure at 170 The Bridle Path is replaced.
