# CITY OF TORONTO

## BY-LAW No. 875-2006

## To amend the former City of Scarborough West Hill Community Zoning By-law No. 10327, as amended, with respect to the lands municipally known as 53 Old Kingston Road.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "A" of the West Hill Community Zoning By-law is amended by deleting Performance Standard 45 and adding 59B and 169B for the lands outlined on Schedule '1' so that the amended zoning shall read as follows on Schedule '1':

S - 8-35-51-59B-66-169B

2. Schedule "B" **PERFORMANCE STANDARDS CHART** is amended by adding Performance Standards 59B and 169B.

#### SIDE YARD

59B. Minimum 2 metres from each side.


#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

- 169B. Minimum 1.5 metre strip of land along **side** and **rear lot lines** shall not be used for any purpose other than **landscaping**.
- **3.** Schedule "C" **EXCEPTIONS LIST** is amended by adding Exception 99 to the lands outlined on Schedule '2' as follows:
  - 99. On those lands identified as Exception 99 on the accompanying Schedule "C" map, the following provisions shall apply:
    - (a) Business and Professional Offices are permitted within the existing structure as it existed on June 13, 2006.
