CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 931-2006

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Columbine Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Columbine Avenue	South	Rainsford Road and a point 22.9 metres east of it	Anytime

B. By deleting from Part A (12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.) in Schedule XXVI (Permit Parking) in § 400-79, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)	(From Column 5)
Columbine Avenue	Odd	From 22.9 metres east of Rainsford Road to Woodbine Avenue	2	All times, except no standing anytime from Woodbine Avenue to a point 15 metres west of it

C. By inserting in Part A (12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.) of Schedule XXVI (Permit Parking) in § 400-79, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Columbine Avenue	Odd	From Rainsford Road to Woodbine Avenue	3	All times

D. By deleting from Schedule XXIX (No Standing) in § 400-82, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Columbine Avenue	South	Woodbine Avenue and a point 15 metres west thereof	Anytime
