**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 948-2006**

**To amend further By-law No. 34-93, a by-law “To provide for disabled person parking permit holders”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, respecting King Edward Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule ‘E’ of By-law No. 34-93, entitled “To provided for disabled person parking permit holders”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, between the words “King Edward Avenue” and “Kings Park Boulevard” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
King Edward Avenue	East	A point 100 metres south of Lumsden Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime during the months of May, July, September and November
King Edward Avenue	West	A point 108 metres south of Lumsden Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime during the months, of January, February, March, April, June, August, October and December
