CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 953-2006

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86 respecting maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads, respecting Harbour Street, Lake Shore Boulevard East and Lake Shore Boulevard West.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule 1 of Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86, as amended, being a By-law "To prescribe maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads", is hereby further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Harbour Street (M.T.2) between Yonge Street and Lake Shore Boulevard East 60 kilometres per hour

Lake Shore Boulevard East, between Yonge Street and Coxwell Avenue 60 kilometres per hour

Lake Shore Boulevard West, between the Humber River and Yonge Street 60 kilometres per hour

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Lake Shore Boulevard East, between a point 100 metres east of Jarvis Street and Coxwell Avenue 60 kilometres per hour

Lake Shore Boulevard West, between the Humber River and a point 100 metres west of Spadina Avenue 60 kilometres per hour
