BY-LAW No. 958-2006

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Blue Jays Way, east/west public laneway at Dermott Place, Miles Place, north/south public laneway at Jersey Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule II (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 400-55, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Blue Jays Way	Navy Wharf Court and a point 30.5 metres east	Northerly westbound	Anytime	Westbound straight through
Blue Jays Way	Navy Wharf Court and a point 30.5 metres east	Southerly westbound	Anytime	Westbound left-turning

B. By inserting in Schedule IV (Stop Intersections) in § 400-57, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
East/west public laneway first south of Carlton Street at Dermott Place (opposite No. 13 Dermott Place)	East/west public laneway (eastbound)
Miles Place and Garnet Avenue	Miles Place (southbound)
Miles Place and Melville Avenue	Miles Place (northbound)
Miles Place and Yarmouth Road	Miles Place (northbound and southbound)

North/south public laneway and south side of North/south public laneway (northbound)
Jersey Avenue (westerly limit)
