BY-LAW No. 966-2006

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Dovercourt Road and Shaw Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Shaw Street	East	A point 71.6 metres north of Logie Place and Argyle Avenue	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.

B. By deleting from Schedule XXV (Time Limit Parking) in § 400-78, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Dovercourt Road	West	A point 30.0 metres south of College Street and a point 12.0 metres further south thereof	9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Sat.	1 hour
Dovercourt Road	West	A point 42.0 metres south of College Street and a point 67.1 metres north of Heydon Park Road	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Sat.	1 hour

C. By inserting in Schedule XXV (Time Limit Parking) in § 400-78, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Dovercourt Road	West	A point 30 metres south of College Street and a point 52.5 metres further south thereof	9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Sat.	2 hours
