BY-LAW No. 969-2006

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86, designating certain locations on former Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers, regarding Albion Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86, being a By-law "To designate certain locations on Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers", as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Albion Road (M.T. 11)	between east side (northbound Albion Road) and centre pedestrian refuge island, approximately seven metres north of Shendale Drive
Albion Road (M.T. 11)	between west side (southbound Albion Road) and centre pedestrian refuge island, approximately seven metres north of Shendale Drive
