BY-LAW No. 1024-2006

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Leslie Street and Sheppard Avenue East.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Sheppard Avenue East (M.T. 28)

Between the easterly limit of Leslie Street and a point 30 metres easterly thereof

2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Leslie Street and Sheppard Avenue East (M.T. 61) Northbound

Right

When traffic control signal shows red

3. This By-law shall be effective commencing December 16, 2006.
