BY-LAW No. 1091-2006

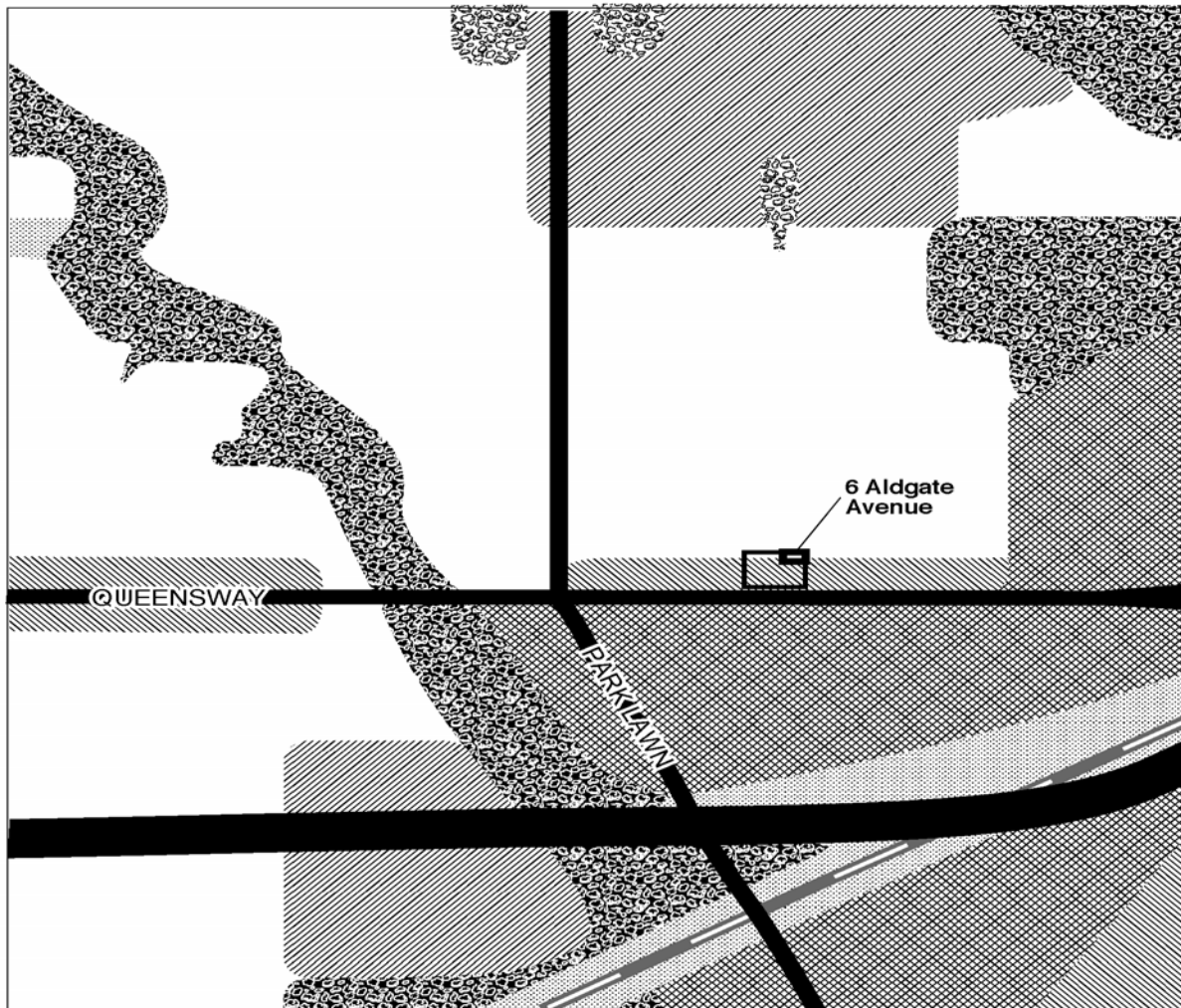
