BY-LAW No. 45-2008

To amend further By-law No. 34-93, a by-law "To provide for disabled person parking permit holders", being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding King Edward Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule 'E' (Designated On-Street Parking for the Disabled) of By-law No. 34-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
King Edward Avenue	East	A point 100 metres south of Lumsden Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime during the months of May, July, September and November
King Edward Avenue	West	A point 108 metres south of Lumsden Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime during the months of January, February, March, April, June, August, October and December
