BY-LAW No. 68-2008

To assume municipal services located in and on Kilsyth Drive and Cameron Glen Boulevard being the streets, and the street widening of Port Union Road on Plan 66M-2295.

WHEREAS the City entered into a Subdivision Agreement with Sugarbridge Properties Inc. and the Agreement was subsequently assigned to Granway Estates Inc. to provide for the public highway and municipal services on Plan 66M-2295 and all affected City Divisions have no objection to the City's intention to assume the municipal services installed pursuant to the Subdivision Agreement;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The municipal services located in and on the streets on Registered Plan 66M-2295, described by W. Kowalenko, City Surveyor, as follows namely:

In the City of Toronto (former City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario, in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66), being composed of:

KILSYTH DRIVE, PLAN 66M2295

SECONDLY: PIN 06506-0323 (LT)
CAMERON GLEN BOULEVARD, PLAN 66M2295

THIRDLY: PIN 06506-0317 (LT)
BLOCK 81 (STREET WIDENING OF PORT UNION ROAD),
PLAN 66M2295

are assumed by the City.
