To repeal By-law No. 1229-2007 being a by-law "To designate the property at 1233 Yonge Street (Aeneas Court Apartments) as being of cultural heritage value or interest".

WHEREAS Council passed by-law 1229-2007 being a by-law to designate the property at 1233 Yonge Street (Aeneas Court Apartments) as being of cultural heritage value or interest; and

WHEREAS the authority granted by Council at its meeting held on July 25, 26 and 27, 2006 provided for the listing of the property on the City's inventory of heritage properties and not for the designation of the property; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to correct this error;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law No. 1229-2007 is repealed.
- 2. The City Solicitor is authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" to this by-law in the proper Land Registry Office.
- **3.** The City Clerk is authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served upon the owners of the property at 1233 Yonge Street and upon the Ontario Heritage Trust and to cause notice of this by-law to be posted on the City's web site for a period of 30 days in accordance with Municipal Code Chapter 162, Notice, Public, Article II, § 162-4, Notice requirements under the *Ontario Heritage Act*.
