**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 102-2008**

**To amend further former Borough of East York By-law No. 92-93, a by-law  
“To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, respecting Brentcliffe Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Road)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)	(From Column 5 Direction)
Brentcliffe Road	A point 30.5 metres south of Eglinton Avenue East and Vanderhoof Avenue	Easterly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound right-turning

2. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)	(In Column 5 Direction)
Brentcliffe Road	A point 30.5 metres south of Eglinton Avenue East and a point 44.5 metres further south	Easterly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound right-turning
Brentcliffe Road	A point 30.5 metres south of Eglinton Avenue East and a point 44.5 metres further south	Westerly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound through and Northbound left-turning
