BY-LAW No. 249-2008

To name the private lanes at 115 Torbarrie Road as "Joseph Griffith Lane" and "Jim Baird Mews".

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed by-law was posted on notice pages of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on February 12, 2008, and it is appropriate to name the private lanes at 115 Torbarrie Road as "Joseph Griffith Lane" and "Jim Baird Mews";

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The proposed private lanes at 115 Torbarrie Road, as shown on Attachment No. 1 to this by-law, be named "Joseph Griffith Lane" and "Jim Baird Mews";
- 2. The owners or their successors of Toronto Common Elements Condominium Plan No. 1902 and its appurtenant interests as set out in Schedule D in Instrument AT1655064 pay the costs, estimated to be in the amount of \$1,800.00, for the fabrication and installation of the street name signs; and
- **3.** The owners or their successors of Toronto Common Elements Condominium Plan No. 1902 and its appurtenant interests as set out in Schedule D in Instrument AT1655064 shall maintain, at its own risk, the signage installed under Section 2 of this By-law.
