BY-LAW No. 259-2008

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Avenue Road/University Avenue, Bayview Avenue, Bloor Street/Danforth Avenue, Dundas Street East, Eglinton Avenue, Finch Avenue West, Lawrence Avenue East, McCowan Road, The Queensway and Yonge Street, in the event of a strike or lockout affecting service by the Toronto Transit Commission.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Finch Avenue West	Both	Highway 400 and Jane Street	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday during T.T.C. labour disruption

Yonge Street	Both	Front Street and Steeles Avenue	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday during T.T.C. labour disruption

2. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Dundas Street East	Both	River Street and Broadview Avenue	Anytime during T.T.C. labour disruption

3. The provisions of this by-law shall apply notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any other by-law or chapter of the Municipal Code, and in addition to any restrictions in any other by-law or Municipal Code chapter and where any prohibition contained in this By-law conflicts with any pre-existing prohibition in Schedule VIII, IX or XI of former Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, the prohibitions in this By-law shall prevail.
4. This By-law shall be effective commencing from 12:01 a.m. on the first day of a Toronto Transit Commission strike or lockout affecting all or a portion of public transit service from and after April 1, 2008, and shall cease to be in effect on the earlier of:
- (i) 12:01 a.m. of the first day following the return to normal transit operations of the Toronto Transit Commission; and

(ii) June 25, 2008.
