CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 262-2008

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, respecting Bay Street and Queens Quay West, in the event of a strike or lockout affecting service by the Toronto Transit Commission.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, of the Municipal Code of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:
 - (1) by adding the following schedule to § 194-7:

Highway Side and Location Between

Bay Street Curb Lanes, Both sides Queens Quay West and

Yorkville Avenue

Queens Quay West Curb Lanes, Both Sides Lower Spadina Avenue and

Yonge Street

- (2) by amending § 194-9A, by inserting "or § 194-7" after "§ 196-6" in the second line; and
- (3) by amending § 194-10, by inserting "or § 194-7" after "§ 196-6" in the second line.
- 2. Section 194-7 of the Municipal Code of the former City of Toronto is amended by deleting the schedule added in section 3(1) of this by-law immediately prior to the time this by-law ceases to be in effect.
- 3. This By-law shall be effective commencing from 12:01 a.m. on the first day of a Toronto Transit Commission strike or lockout affecting all or a portion of public transit service from and after April 1, 2008, and shall cease to be in effect on the earlier of:
 - (i) 12:01 a.m. of the first day following the return to normal transit operations of the Toronto Transit Commission; and
 - (ii) June 25, 2008.
