**BY-LAW No. 290-2008**

**To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, respecting Lea Avenue.**

The North York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Road)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and Days)
Lea Avenue	North	Randolph Road and a point 49 metres east of Randolph Road	Anytime

2. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting in the Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, between the words “Lane” and “Leacrest Road” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and Days)
Lea Avenue	North	Randolph Road and a point 22 metres east	Anytime
Lea Avenue	North	A point 28 metres east of Randolph Road and a point 49 metres east of Randolph Road	Anytime
