BY-LAW No. 312-2008

To amend By-law No. 54-2000 to permit the removal of the existing speed hump on Crawford Street, south of Sully Crescent.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 54-2000, being “A By-law to further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being ‘A By-law to authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations’, respecting the alteration of Crawford Street by the installation of speed humps from Dundas Street West to College Street”, is amended to permit the removal of the existing speed hump on Crawford Street, south of Sully Crescent, at the location shown on Drawing No. 421F-9131 dated November 2007, on file with the Director of Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District.
