BY-LAW No. 331-2008

**To permanently close a portion of the public lane between Hiawatha Road and
Ashdale Avenue.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public lane located at the rear of 151 Hiawatha Road be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Toronto and East York Community Council Item 11.52, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on December 11, 12 and 13, 2007; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said public lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting held on April 8, 2008;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public lane located at the rear of 151 Hiawatha Road, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public lane:

Being part of Lane, Plan 1357 Toronto designated as Part 3 on Plan 66R-21536,
