CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 342-2008

To amend the former City of North York Zoning By-law No. 7625, as amended, with respect to lands municipally known as 661 Sheppard Avenue West.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Schedules "B" and "C" of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York are amended in accordance with Schedule "1" of this By-law.
- 2. Section 64.13 of By-law No. 7625 is amended by adding the following subsection:

"64.13(76) R4(76)

PERMITTED USES

(a) In addition to the uses permitted in the R4 zone, business and professional offices shall be permitted within the existing One-Family Detached Dwelling, existing on the date of enactment of this By-law.

EXCEPTION REGULATIONS

- (b) The gross floor area attributed to the business and professional offices shall not exceed 103 m^2 .
- (c) For all buildings and structures existing on or before the date of enactment of the By-law, a minimum lot frontage of 12.19 metres shall be maintained.
- (d) For all buildings and structures existing on or before the date of enactment of the By-law, a minimum lot area of 535.10 m^2 shall be maintained.
- (e) A minimum of 5 parking spaces for the use of both offices and a residential dwelling unit shall be provided.
- (f) For all buildings and structures existing on or before the date of enactment of the By-law, the minimum two-way driveway width shall be 3.36 metres.

- (g) A minimum 0.69 m wide landscape buffer comprised of lawn and shrubs and a 1.5 metre high opaque fence shall be provided along the east boundary line of the site.
- (h) A 0.0 metre landscape buffer and a 1.8 metre high opaque fence shall be maintained along the west boundary line of the site.
- (i) The minimum front and side yard setbacks on the lands as shown in Schedule "R4(76)" attached hereto shall be maintained."
