BY-LAW No. 358-2008

To amend By-law No. 533-2007 to extend the expiration of Part Lot Control exemption for lands municipally known as portions of 147 Brandon Avenue.

WHEREAS Council on May 25, 2007 enacted By-law No. 533-2007 to exempt lands municipally known as portions of 147 Brandon Avenue from Part Lot Control exemption for a period of one year from the date of its enactment; and

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 50(7.4) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this by-law to extend the time period specified in By-law No. 533-2007 for the expiration of Part Lot Control exemption;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Section 2 of By-law No. 533-2007 is deleted and the following is substituted for it:
 - This By-law expires two years from the date of its enactment by Council.
- **2.** This By-law applies only to the lands described in the attached Schedule "A".
