## CITY OF TORONTO

## BY-LAW No. 438-2008

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt the fence on the property municipally known as 1355 Kingston Road, which fence forms part of the swimming pool enclosure for 41 Lynndale Road, from the minimum standards for chain-link fence construction.

The Scarborough Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule A to Chapter 447, Fences, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing chain-link fence located in the rear yard of the property known as 1355 Kingston Road, constructed of 50 millimetre chain-link, may continue to form part of the swimming pool enclosure for the pool located in the rear yard of 41 Lynnwood Road, despite the maximum mesh size of 38 millimetres in § 447-3E(2)(a) for such fences, provided that, should the fence not be maintained to the minimum standards set out in Chapter 447, the pool shall be drained and temporary fencing installed until Chapter 447 is complied with.
