## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW No. 462-2008**

#### **To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, to make changes to the size of various Business Improvement Area Boards of Management.**

WHEREAS Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code designates various areas of the City as Business Improvement Areas; and

WHEREAS Toronto and East York Community Council, under delegated authority, has approved the removal of some members from some Boards of Management, and the appointment of members to various Business Improvement Area Boards of Management, for a term expiring on November 30, 2010, or as soon thereafter as successors are appointed; and

WHEREAS Schedule A of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, must be amended to reflect the change in the number of members and the number required for quorum of the various Business Improvement Area Boards of Management;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The table in Schedule A of the Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, is hereby amended as follows:
  - (1) by changing the number of members of the Beach Business Improvement Area Board of Management from 11 to 10;
  - (2) by changing the number of members of the Bloordale Business Improvement Area Board of Management from 7 to 8;
  - (3) by changing the number of members of the Danforth Village Business Improvement Area Board of Management from 13 to 12, and the number required for quorum from 5 to 4;
  - (4) by changing the number of members of the Forest Hill Village Business Improvement Area Board of Management from 9 to 7; and
  - (5) by changing the number of members of the Old Cabbagetown Town Business Improvement Area Board of Management from 14 to 15.
