BY-LAW No. 603-2008

**To exempt certain lands municipally known as 315 – 325 Dalesford Road from
Part Lot Control.**

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, does not apply to the lands described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
2. This By-law expires one year after its enactment by Council.

SCHEDULE “A”**Legal Description:**

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) being composed of:

Parcel 461-A, Section M-110; Firstly: Lots 461, 461, 463, 464 & 465, Plan M-110; Secondly: Part of Milton Street, Plan M-110, being the Easterly half thereof, lying between the Northerly limit of Cambridge Street (now Mendota Street) Street and the southerly limit of Brant Street (now Dalesford Road); Plan M-110, City of Toronto (formerly City of Etobicoke).

Parcel 316-1, Section M-110; Firstly: Part of Lots 316, 317, 318, 319 & 320, Plan M-110; being composed the Easterly one hundred and ten feet (110') in perpendicular width throughout from front the rear of Lots 316 to 320, both inclusive, Plan M-110; Secondly: Part of Milton Street (closed), Plan M-110, being the westerly half thereof, lying between the northerly limit of Cambridge Street (now Mendota Street) and the southerly limit of Brant Street (now Dalesford Road), Plan M-110, City of Toronto (formerly City of Etobicoke).
