BY-LAW No. 645-2008

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 108-86, designating certain locations on former Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers, regarding Brimley Road, Danforth Road, Lake Shore Boulevard West, Lawrence Avenue West and Weston Road.

The Council of City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86, being a By-law "To designate certain locations on Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers", as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

| Brimley Road | At Bernadine Street/Applefield Drive |

| Lake Shore Boulevard West | 3 metres south of Hillside Avenue |

| Lawrence Avenue West (M.T. 22) | Between south side (eastbound Lawrence Avenue West) and centre pedestrian refuge island approximately 15 metres west of Brookhaven Road |
| Lawrence Avenue West (M.T. 22) | Between north side (westbound Lawrence Avenue West) and centre pedestrian refuge island approximately 15 metres west of Brookhaven Road |
| Weston Road | Approximately 67 metres north of Habitant Drive |
