CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 719-2008

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 629, Property Standards, to make a technical amendment to § 629-19F, as enacted by By-law No. 349-2008.

WHEREAS on April 29, 2008, Council enacted By-law No. 349-2008, “To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 629, Property Standards, to add specific standards for guards, handrails, lighting levels and hot water.”; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 349-2008 enacted several provisions applying to all buildings having a building area “exceeding 600 square metres” or “not exceeding 600 square meters”; and

WHEREAS there is a technical error in § 629-19F, as enacted by Section 1B of By-law No. 349-2008, as Subsection F refers to “600 square millimetres” instead of “600 square metres”; and

WHEREAS under § 169-26 of Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 629-19F of Chapter 629, Property Standards, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code (as enacted by By-law No. 349-2008) is amended by deleting “millimetres” after “600 square” and substituting “metres”, in the second line of the first sentence of Subsection F.
2. This amendment is deemed to have come into force on April 29, 2008.
