CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 820-2008

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, respecting bicycle lanes on Birchmount Road, Royal York Road, Simcoe Street/Lower Simcoe Street and Stanley Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:
