BY-LAW No. 829-2008

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways,
Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, respecting bicycle lanes on Carlaw Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, of the City of Toronto is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Carlaw Avenue	Riverdale Avenue and a point 39 metres north of Victor Avenue	Southbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Anytime
Carlaw Avenue	A point 39 metres north of Victor Avenue and a point 41 metres south of Victor Avenue	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Carlaw Avenue	A point 41 metres south of Victor Avenue and Simpson Avenue	Southbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Anytime
