BY-LAW No. 1017-2008

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Highway No. 2 and Kingston Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

Highway No. 2 (M.T. 4)	Both	A point 30 metres west of Rylander Boulevard and the Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto/Region of Durham Boundary	Anytime
Kingston Road (M.T.4)	Both	Sheppard Avenue and King's Highway No. 401	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Kingston Road	North and West	Easterly limit of the City of Toronto and King's Highway No. 401	Anytime
Kingston Road	South and East	King's Highway No. 401 and Port Union Road	Anytime
Kingston Road	South and East	King's Highway No. 401 Westbound Off-Ramp and easterly limit of the City of Toronto	Anytime

2. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Kingston Road	South and East	Port Union Road and King's Highway No. 401 Westbound Off-Ramp	Anytime
