BY-LAW No. 1026-2008

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways,
Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, respecting Conlins Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths and Bicycle Lanes, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Conlins Road	A point 36.5 metres north of Ellesmere Road and Good Road	Northbound lane adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Anytime
Conlins Road	Ellesmere Road and a point 36.5 metres north of Ellesmere Road	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Conlins Road	Ellesmere Road and Sheppard Avenue East	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Conlins Road	Good Road and Sheppard Avenue East	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
