BY-LAW No. 1079-2008

To authorize the alteration of Rushton Road, between Benson Avenue and St. Clair Avenue West, by the installation of three speed humps.

WHEREAS a traffic calming poll of households on Rushton Road, between Benson Avenue and St. Clair Avenue West, was conducted and, as the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Rushton Road;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of three speed humps on Rushton Road, between Benson Avenue and St. Clair Avenue West, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-9151 dated December, 2007, on file in the offices of Transportation Services.
