BY-LAW No. 1080-2008

To authorize the alteration of St. Clarens Avenue, between College Street and Bloor Street West, by the installation of nine speed humps.

WHEREAS a traffic calming poll of households on St. Clarens Avenue, between College Street and Bloor Street West, was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on St. Clarens Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of nine speed humps on St. Clarens Avenue, between College Street and Bloor Street West, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-9100 dated October, 2007, on file in the offices of Transportation Services.
