BY-LAW No. 1288-2008

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Bay Street, Harbour Street and Yonge Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Yonge Street (M.T. 29)	Between the south curb line of Lake Shore Boulevard Eastbound and a point 30.5 Metres north of the north curb line of Lake Shore Boulevard Eastbound

2. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the words and figures:
