**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 1302-2008**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 140, Lobbying, to change the suspension of the registration requirements in § 140-4E for not-for-profit community services sector organizations to an exemption.**

WHEREAS under § 140-4A of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 140, Lobbying, the members, members' staff, officers and employees of not-for-profit organizations are exempt from the registration requirements of Chapter 140, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, in the case of not-for-profit community services sector organizations Council authorized a suspension of the registration requirements in § 140-4E for grant applications, awards or other financial benefits, as set out in Executive Committee Item 22.5, adopted as amended, by City of Toronto Council on July 15, 16 and 17, 2008; and has now authorized an exemption as set out in Executive Committee Item 26.22, as adopted by City of Toronto Council on December 1, 2 and 3, 2008;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 140-4F is deleted and the following substituted:

“F. Subsection E does not apply to an organization as defined in Subsection C of the definition of “organization” in § 140-1 that is a not-for-profit community services sector organization and, for greater certainty, is not a not-for-profit organization described in Subsection C.”
