BY-LAW No. 1324-2008

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 510, Holiday Shopping, to require
Retail Business Establishments to close on Family Day.**

WHEREAS in accordance with the *Retail Business Holidays Act*, R.S.O. 1990, C. R.30, retail business establishments are required to close on Family Day; and

WHEREAS Council has determined that it is desirable to require retail business establishments in the City of Toronto to close on Family Day unless such establishments are located in a designated tourist exemption area;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 510, Holiday Shopping, § 510-1, Definitions, is amended by adding the words "Family Day" to the definition of HOLIDAY.
