To name the existing private road, being the westerly extension of "Sherway Gardens Road", west of Sherway Gate, as "Sherway Gardens Road".

WHEREAS City of Toronto Council has delegated the legislative authority for local routine matters, such as the naming of streets, to Community Councils by adopting Executive Committee Item 2.5, as amended, at its meeting held on February 5, 6, 7 and 8, 2007; and

WHEREAS pursuant to § 27-152E(5) of Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Etobicoke York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law naming the private road;

The Etobicoke York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The existing private road, being the westerly extension of Sherway Gardens Road, west of Sherway Gate, be named as "Sherway Gardens Road", as shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law.
- 2. Menkes Developments Inc., its agent or successor pay the cost, estimated to be in the amount of \$420.00, for the fabrication and installation of a street name sign.
