BY-LAW No. 228-2010

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Grenville Street and Grosvenor Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

- A. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Grosvenor Street	South	A point 60 metres east of Bay Street and Yonge Street	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Grosvenor Street	South	Bay Street and Yonge Street	Anytime

- C. By deleting from Schedule XXIV (No Stopping) in § 400-77, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Grenville Street	North	Bay Street and a point 52 metres east	Anytime
Grosvenor Street	Both	Bay Street and a point 60 metres east	Anytime
