BY-LAW No. 344-2010

To establish an obligatory reserve fund named the Pavement Degradation Fee Reserve Fund, and to amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds accordingly.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** (1) The Pavement Degradation Fee Reserve Fund is hereby established for the purpose of funding the reconstruction, resurfacing and maintenance of pavement.
 - (2) City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, be amended by adding the following to Schedule No. 14 State of Good Repair Obligatory Reserve Funds:

"Pavement Degradation Fee Transportation Services

Provides a source of funding for reconstruction, resurfacing and maintenance of pavement."
