BY-LAW No. 464-2010

To permanently close a portion of Lower Sherbourne Street.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of Lower Sherbourne Street be permanently closed as public highway in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in Toronto and East York Community Council Item 32.24, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on March 31 and April 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting held on April 27, 2010;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of Lower Sherbourne Street, described as follows:

Part of PIN 21384-0078 (LT)
Being Part of Sherbourne St Plan 666E Toronto (AKA Lower Sherbourne Street)
Between Lakeshore Blvd and Queens Quay, Toronto,
designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-24744, City of Toronto
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66),

is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
