BY-LAW No. 505-2010

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Markham Road and Steeles Avenue East.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures:
