BY-LAW No. 749-2010

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law "To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York", being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Cedarvale Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and Days)
Cedarvale Avenue	East	A point 126 metres north of Cosburn Avenue and a point 60 metres further north	9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. of one day to 8:30 a.m. of the next following day, Mon. to Fri.; Anytime Sat., Sun. and Public Holidays

2. Schedule X (Parking for Restricted Periods) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is hereby further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Times and Days)	(In Column 5 Max. Period Permitted)
Cedarvale Avenue	East	A point 126 metres north of Cosburn Avenue and a point 60 metres further north	8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.	10 mins.
