BY-LAW No. 776-2010

To permanently close the public lane extending westerly from Alvin Avenue between the two properties municipally known as 50 and 54 Alvin Avenue.

WHEREAS it is recommended that the public lane extending westerly from Alvin Avenue between the two properties municipally known as 50 and 54 Alvin Avenue be permanently closed as a public lane and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Toronto and East York Community Council Item 33.42, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on May 11 and 12, 2010; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting held on June 22, 2010;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane extending westerly from Alvin Avenue between the two properties municipally known as 50 and 54 Alvin Avenue, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public lane:
